Three or more leading zeros, Ending in 4 zeros, Leading # of 9 (it is a tax ID number issued by IRS)
It is suggested you post a copy of this chart in the office where you process applications so you can make comparisons of the SSN's provided by applicants.

***Ask your prospective tenant this question. "There are some people in _____ (state) with your last name. Have you ever lived there? If they say no it may be a fraudulent social security number.
